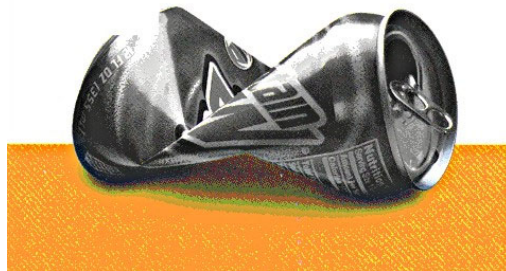


SOFT DRINKS are HARD on TEETH
