According to the American Dental Association around 30% of dental hygienists and dental assistants are anticipated to retire in the next five years. South Dakota is not unaffected by this shortage. A 2023 survey conducted by the South Dakota Dental Association found that 58% of offices polled were looking for a dental hygienist and 74% were looking for an assistant. The South Dakota Oral

Health Coalition has a task force that has been focusing on encouraging and engaging youth to think about a career in the dental field. One of the efforts is a flyer that can be displayed at career fairs or in guidance counselor's offices, dental offices, biology classrooms or front offices. 
